IZUMI GREEN VILLAGE

The area called "Izumi District" is located in the suburb of Chiba City. Thanks to Kashima River, the district is a rich agriculture zone, dubbed "Green Village." Once you get out of the business and residential area of Chishirodai Town, you will be in the middle of the countryside.

THE TOUR

The route is about 30km long, laid out by Watanabe. The highlight of the tour includes rice paddies, dairy cattle ranch, farm product shops, traditional houses, one of which is where Emperor Meiji once rested, and Izumi Nature Park. Popular experiences include trying locallymade ice cream.

Optional byways include walkthrough in Izumi Woods for forest -bathing, Herb Garden, where you might want to try herb tea and cake.

The length of the tour is 4 hour, or longer, depending on options.

Minimum guest count is 1, maximum guest count is 4.

ITINERARY

■ Meeting/Start/End point: In front of Chishirodai station, Chiba Monorail Exit 2, on the ground.

■ Meeting at 10:00, Departure at 10:30, End at 14:00 or later de-

pending on options.

■ If you have time preference on itinerary, your preference would be accommodated. Please ask.

FEE

Fee: 4,000 yen, adult, w/ bike rental. 2,800 yen, adult, w/o bike rental.

Family discount is available for a 2nd adult 3,200 yen, for a child 2,800 yen.

Note: The fee does not cover lunch and any other foods and drinks.

Payment method: To be paid in cash and in person only.

RESERVATION AND CANCELLATION

Reservation: e-mail (preferred) or phone. See "CONTACT" at the end.

■ Acceptance: First come, first served basis.

TIPS

Bring your cap, gloves, health insurance, ID, foods & drink (can be purchased on the way).

Note that a bicycle helmet is not required for adult by the regulations in Japan. Cancellation: The tour may be cancelled when bad weather is expected. The cancellation is notified via e-mail, no later than 17:00 of previous day.

■ Use a rental bike included in the fee, or bring your own bike.

Insurance for injury and indemnity are recommended for your own protection. If you are not sure, ask.

ACCESS

Monorail is recommended, but if you use a car, coin-operated parking is available nearby.

From JR, transfer to Chiba Monorail bound for Chishirodai station, at JR Chiba-Minato, JR Chiba, or JR Tsuga station.

From Makuhari area, take JR Keiyo line to go to Chiba Minato station (8 min.), transfer to Chiba Monorail to go to Chishirodai (29 min.)

■ From Narita area, take JR line to go to Tsuga station (28 min.)

■ From Tokyo area, there are two ways;

1. JR line to go to Chiba station (40min.), where transfer to Chiba Monorail to go to Chishirodai station (25 min.);

2. Expressway Bus for Chishirodai at Keisei Bus Stop No. 3, Yaesuguchi, Tokyo station, departing Tokyo at 9:10, arriving Chishirodai at 10:26 (76 min.).

Note that the travel time is approximate, which does not include walking and waiting time.
